TO ALL OUR VALUED GUESTS:

We value your health and safety and have been working closely with municipal, provincial and public health officials to determine when the park can open safely for the 2020 season. The Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing has confirmed that the trailer park is not an essential service and the park was officially closed by the Minister at 11:59 p.m. on April 4, 2020 until further notice. The Minister has advised that enforcement efforts by the Ministry may include tickets issued under the Provincial Offenses Act for those who do not comply with that order. We are therefore asking that nobody other than those with no other permanent address in Canada attend the site for any purpose until further notice. Our existing clients with no other permanent address in Ontario who wish to use their existing site for quarantine purposes must contact the office to make special arrangements and will be required to comply with strict rules.

Like you, we are anxious to get the spring season under way as soon as it is safe to do so. At the current time, we do not anticipate that it will be feasible to open prior to May 31, 2020. We will also consider remaining open to the end of October 2020, weather permitting, to recapture as much of the season as possible. In all likelihood, when we do re-open, it will be with some new social distancing rules in place to ensure everyone's continuing health and safety.

We will be posting new 2020 applications to our website shortly and will be asking everyone to sign a new application agreeing to the new social distancing rules once they have been established by health officials. Invoices for the balance of the seasonal fees are being mailed and full payment for the season is required by May 1st, 2020. In the interim, you may wish to refer to your 2019 deposit invoice for the total amount less deposit paid. In the event of a shortened season, prorated credit will be provided towards the 2021 season. To facilitate payment, we ask that you e-transfer funds to customersupport@ogpl.ca in accordance with the most recent rules imposed by the provincial government.
